### 2016/2017 Application Form

## Scholarships will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- successful completion of grade 12 with a minimum of a 3.00 GPA in grades 11 and 12;
- involvement in the community including volunteer experiences;
- willing to learn Sikh history and Sikh religious principles;
- acceptance to a Canadian University;
- Canadian citizen or landed immigrant.

Note: Scholarships will be provided one time for \$500.

#### **Important**

A complete application consists of the following elements:

#### **Required:**

this application form, fully completed and signed;

- an essay of up to 500 words on "How this scholarship will help meet my future plans academically and spiritually;"
- a letter of reference from your school, written by a guidance counsellor, teacher or principal;
- one other letter of reference, preferably by someone who has observed you in a work or volunteer environment;
- a transcript of your academic record.

#### **Optional:**

 An essay of up to 250 words, describing your family and personal circumstances (family employment, economic situation, etc.), or other extenuating circumstances you feel may be relevant to the consideration of your application. All applications and correspondence should be sent to:
